



What's the cost of keeping your on-premises phone system?



If you're still holding on to your on-premises phone system, dealing with clunky infrastructure and costly upkeep, you're not alone. Nearly 50% of organizations still have at least a partial deployment of on-premises phone systems, and 70% of those systems were purchased more than five years ago.¹

What keeps organizations tethered?

According to Metrigy research, seven factors limit organizations from fully moving beyond their on-premises phone system:

- Legacy devices
- Scale
- Customizations
- Existing integrations
- Security
- Reliability
- **Cost**

But what if cost isn't a limiting factor? As it turns out, you can see a payback on your investment in as little as a few months after switching to a cloud-based phone system like Zoom Phone.

Debunking cost concerns

Zoom commissioned Metrigy Research to conduct a benchmark Total Cost of Ownership (TCO) study in 2025 comparing the TCO of Zoom Phone with the TCO of maintaining organizations' premises-based phone systems. All the following insights are drawn from that study.

According to the study, depending on your existing implementation, **you could pay back your entire investment in Zoom Phone in as little as 2 months.**

Licensing costs

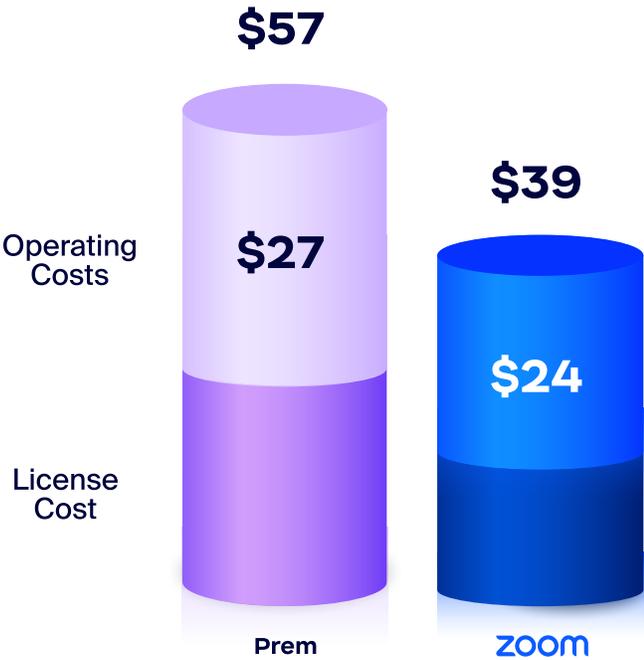
57% of organizations in the study migrated to a subscription model, paying monthly for their premises-based PBX. The average monthly license cost for these organizations was \$30 per user per month.

Compare that with Zoom Phone's \$15 per-license per-month list price for a savings of \$9 per user, which adds up to **\$9,000 in monthly savings or \$108,000 in annual savings for an organization of 1,000.**



Operational and maintenance costs

It pays to look at more than just the upfront price of your licenses. For a more complete picture, we're also looking at the ongoing costs to operate and maintain your on-premises system versus Zoom Phone's cloud-based phone solution.



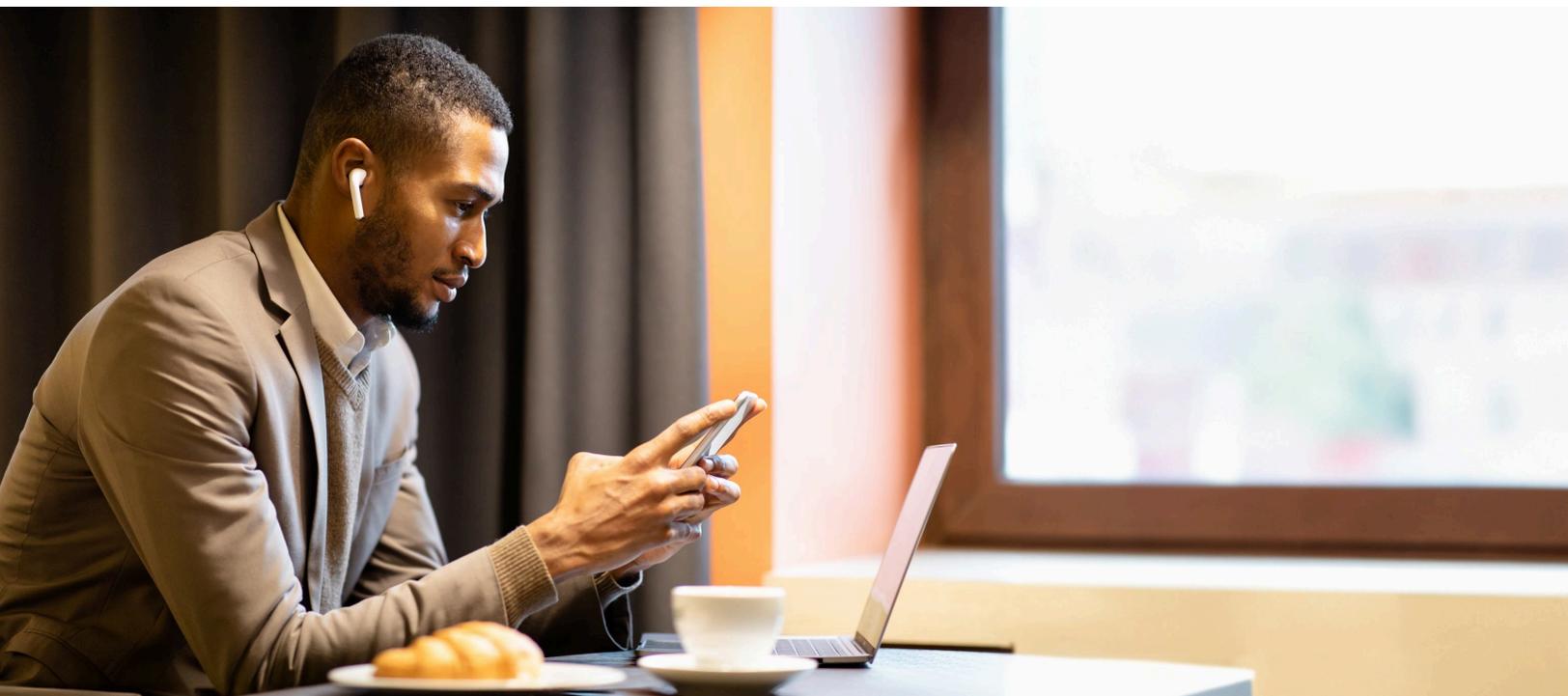
Consider the time and resources it takes to maintain, repair, and upgrade your on-premises infrastructure, and it's no surprise that switching to Zoom Phone can save you an additional \$3 per user per month on average.

Zoom Phone's TCO is \$18 less per user per month than the average on-premises system included in the study. For an organization with 1,000 phone users, that adds up to a whopping **\$18,000 in cost savings per month or \$216,000 annually.**

But what if you could also save money on your PSTN costs? Premises-based systems in the survey reported a mode of spending \$8 per user per month on PSTN.

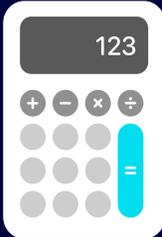
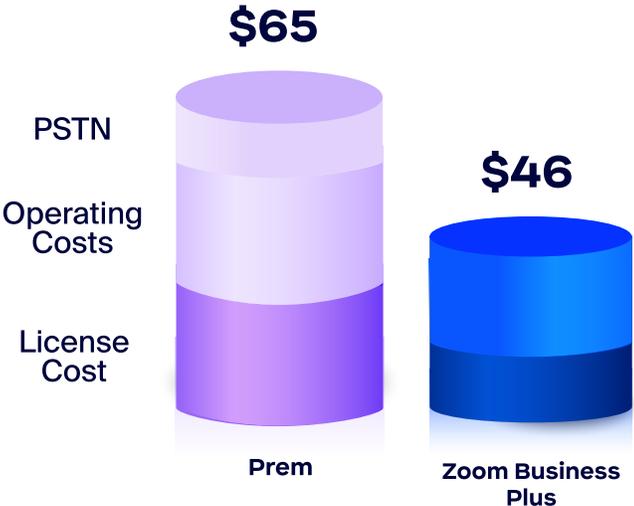
